



HOMICIDE SUSPECT ARRESTED

A suspect has been arrested for his alleged involvement in a homicide. The suspect has been identified as Aurelio Reyes, 42 years, Transient, Marysville, Ca.

On January 19, 2021, at approximately 5:51 pm., MPD officers were called to the front of the Adventist Rideout Hospital Emergency room entrance for a 29-year-old male victim who appeared to have been shot. Adventist Rideout medical personnel and Bi-County Ambulance personnel performed emergency medical treatment. The victim succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased a short time later.

MPD officers identified witnesses who were in the area at the time of the shooting. The investigation revealed Reyes had shot the victim with an unknown type of rifle while on the Marysville Levee, located behind the 300 block of 1st Street. Any possible motive and actions leading up to the shooting remains under investigation.

On January 21, 2021, MPD officers and detective's received information that Reyes was staying at an encampment north of the Marysville City Cemetery. MPD officers located Reyes in a mobile home trailer within the area identified. Reyes surrendered and was taken into custody without incident.

Reyes has been booked for 187(a) PC – Murder; and 245(a)(1) PC – Assault with a Deadly Weapon. Reyes remains in custody at the Yuba County Jail with a bail amount of \$1 million pending future court proceedings.
