## NOTICE TO ALARM PERMIT APPLICANTS

PLEASE READ AND INITIAL ALL SECTIONS OF THE "NOTICE TO ALARM PERMIT APPLICANTS"
ON PAGE 2 OF THIS APPLICATION. BE SURE TO COMPLETE, SIGN AND INITIAL THIS APPLICATION
IN ALL AREAS, OR IT WILL BE RETURNED TO APPLICANT FOR COMPLETION, WHICH WILL RESULT
IN A DELAY IN RECEIVING YOUR PERMIT FOR USE.

Marysville Municipal Code 5.50 regulates burglary and robbery alarms, authorizes imposition of permit fees and establishes fees for false alarms.

Every person who has a burglary and/or robbery alarm system must file an application and receive a permit from the Chief of Police. The fee for the permit is forty dollars (\$40.00) and is valid for one year.

## Restrictions and regulations of the permit area as follows:

1. The permit shall be issued to the person who is legally in possession of the property protected			
by the alarm and the permit must be displayed on the premises of the protected property.			
2. The permit cannot be transferred without the written consent of the Chief of Police.			
Initial: 3. The permit may be revoked for any violation of MMC 5.50, when the alarm activates 10 false			
alarms within a fiscal year or for failure to pay a service fee within 60 days of billing.			
Initial: 4. The permittee shall be charged a service fee for any false alarm which the Police Department			
responds to within a fiscal year (July through June), at a rate of:			
1. \$50 (Waivable if permittee completes an alarm training course approved by Chief of			
Police or their designee within fifteen days after a statement has been furnished to the			
responsible party.			
2. \$50 (if permittee was granted a waiver for first False Alarm Fee) \$100 (if first alarm fee			
was NOT waived)			
3. \$100 (if permittee was granted a waiver for first False Alarm Fee) \$150 (if first alarm			
fee was NOT waived.			
City of Marysville Municipal Code Fee Schedule.			
Initial: 5. Audible alarms must have an automatic shut-off that deactivates the sound after 30 minutes.			
Initial: 6 Alarms which emit a siren sound or automatically dial the Police Department or telephone			
company are not permitted.			
Initial: 7. Alarm permits are subject to reasonable conditions imposed by the Chief of Police.			
Initial: 8. Permittee must immediately notify the Police Department of any changes in information			
contained within the application which occurs after issuance of the permit.
